What is "Meet the Makers?"

This is a one-day event for our **trade members** featuring hands-on activities and live demonstrations throughout the day that highlight the skill, craft, and creative talent that sets our products apart from lesser-quality mass produced items.

How do showrooms participate?

Any showroom may participate by inviting a manufacturer they represent to provide an artisan to come to MDC to demonstrate their craft or lead a hands-on activity that demonstrates how their products are made.

Examples might include a person who adds carving or hand-applied finishes to a furniture item, a person who leads a screen-printing activity trade members can try themselves, or an artist who uses an unusual medium or method to create their one-of-a-kind pieces.

How will the day be scheduled?

Once your showroom has decided which "maker" you will invite, select a **block of time** that the maker will be on hand in your showroom space demonstrating their craft. We strongly recommend a two to three hour time block (minimum) so that trade members may attend as many showroom demonstrations as possible.

MDC will provide one large tent that will be set up near the North entrance where three keynote demonstrations may be held. This outdoor space will be ideal for a craftsperson whose demonstration might be on the messy side, create fumes, or may require special equipment not suited to an indoor showroom (blacksmith, anything requiring a power nail gun or spray paint, etc). These tent demonstrations must be secured in advance by contacting Patty in the Resource Center. There will only be three time slots available for the tent, and we want to be sure the three demonstrations are something special and unique that will draw a good audience.

Be a good neighbor!

This is not the day to provide lunch or a presentation in your showroom that is set for a specific time. We have received lots of feedback from past events, and showrooms overwhelmingly do not like too much overlap in the schedule. This causes trade members to miss out on things they would like to attend because too many things are happening at the same time. We urge showrooms to schedule their demos in a more open-house style over a period of a few hours so designers can stop in and see as many different demos as they like. Serving food is strictly optional, but if you like, please plan refreshments that can be grazed on throughout the day.
