The number of individually hand-tied knots created by five weavers sitting side-by-side for five to six months in order to produce a nine-foot by 12-foot Tufenkian carpet. Each step of the rug-making process is performed by hand: shearing the sheep, washing the wool in a river, carrying the wool to dry high atop mountain plateaus, then carding, spinning, and dying—all before reaching the weavers.
