“The jumping off point for the fireplace started with the peacock tiles,” Guidry says. Quintessentially Detroit, gorgeous handcrafted Pewabic tiles adorn the double-sided fireplace, with each side being slightly different. The kitchen-facing side has a colorful centerpiece and is framed with an iridescent tile border, while the opposite side is more monochromatic.

The designers also took the white-painted brick back to its historical roots. “Initially, all of the interior brick was painted white” Kapadia explains. “And we were going to distress the paint by roughing it up, but along the way we discovered that it would be a very labor-intensive process, so it was completely stripped out,” Guidry adds.
