During construction, the homeowner approached the designers with a request to incorporate a large antique chest she had fallen in love with. The team found the perfect place for it in the powder room, repurposing it into a handsome vanity with a shell-pattern sink and faucet. “This piece has some of the most traditional elements that we brought into the house,” LaVictor says.

The designers say that finding the right wallcovering to blend with the onyx vanity countertop and backsplash was another challenge. Instead of using wallpaper, they hired an artist to hand-paint the walls. This allowed the artist to custom stencil a pearlescent, metallic finish over a complementary base, creating a sophisticated backdrop.
