BUNKROOM BEDLEM

This space proved to be a bit arduous for the designers. “We redesigned these bunk beds at least 50 times to try to fit them in,” Runsat says. One obstructing factor was the window. “The original request included a queen bed, but there just wasn’t enough room without blocking the window,” LaVictor explains. A central staircase with a small platform at the top is safer and easier to climb than a standard ladder. “I wanted a slide, but everyone shot me down,” Runsat jokes. Domed sconces (no sharp edges to bump little heads) illuminate each of the beds and neutral shiplap adds visual texture to the space.
