LITTLE DETAILS

As with many spaces in this home, the design began with the wallcovering. “Before the bunkbeds were even designed, we found this dragonfly wallcovering,” LaVictor says. Designed with children in mind, the bathroom features thoughtful details like chair-rail molding for safe gripping and faucets tailored for little hands. They also prioritized maintenance. “It’s a kid’s bath, so it needed to be easy to clean and maintain, so we ran the tile around the bathroom,” Runsat explains. “It actually extends into the shower and tub area and acts as a niche for shampoo bottles.”
